JANUARY 2 – JANUARY 31

Recology will collect holiday trees curbside for composting between January 2nd and January 31st. Please note that trees may be collected by a vehicle other than your regular compost collection vehicle.



FOR PROPER TREE COLLECTION PLEASE FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS:

- 1 Remove all decorations and tree stands (flocked trees are accepted).
- 2 Place tree next to your green Compost Cart (or place inside with trunk sticking out).
- 3 Trees larger than 8 ft will need to be cut in half in order to be collected. If you have an oversized tree, please contact Recology for a special collection at no charge.

After January 31st, please cut the trees to fit inside your Compost Cart.

 - 4 Use cloth napkins and tablecloths instead of single-use paper or plastic options.
 - 5 Say "NO THANK YOU" to utensils when ordering take-out or delivery to avoid unnecessary plastic waste.
