## FROM THE BELMONT CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

### Dear Neighbor,

The past year and our work together through this crisis have taught us that Belmont does not have enough local control and capacity to be self-sufficient in the event of an emergency. Sacramento continues to redirect our state-administered tax dollars away from Belmont, preventing us from being self-reliant and able to count on spending our tax dollars on services for Belmont residents.



This is why we've re-launched YOUR VOICE, YOUR BELMONT, to hear your needs and priorities again during this year's budget process. Belmont residents have so far identified the following 2021 priorities:

- ✓ Fixing potholes, and repairing streets and sidewalks
- ✓ Maintaining 9-1-1 emergency response times
- ✓ Maintaining parks, open space and sports fields
- ✓ Maintaining neighborhood police patrols and crime prevention
- ✓ Maintaining streets, like Ralston Avenue and keeping other projects like sewer upgrades on-time and on-budget
- ✓ Keeping public areas healthy, safe and clean
